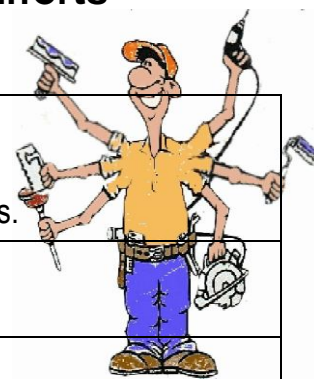


Join us on a Mission Work Trip with *Helping Hands*

WHAT	<p>Helping Hands of Lehigh Presbytery mission work trip to assist in the recovery efforts in South Carolina after flooding caused extensive damage to churches and homes.</p>
WHEN	<p>April 14-21, 2018</p>
WHERE	<p>Summerton, South Carolina</p>
WHO	<p>Adult women and men – 16 and older ready to help and provide hope to others (Ages 16 and 17 need to be accompanied by an adult)</p>
WORK	<p>Reconstruction projects on damaged homes. No specific skills or experience are required, but be prepared to BE FLEXIBLE and provide whatever help is needed. Skills such as plumbing, electrical, roofing, and dry wall installation are always welcomed.</p>
LODGING	<p>We will be staying at Summerton Presbyterian Church, 16 S. Cantey St., Summerton, South Carolina in the manse. There are showers and bathrooms available on site. Please bring air mattresses and bring sleeping bags.</p>
FOOD AND WATER	<p>Meals will be provided. (Bring a reusable water bottle)</p>
TRAVEL	<p>Transportation for this trip will be by rented 15 passenger vans and a cargo van to transport tools.</p>
COST TO PARTICIPANTS	<p>\$200 for the week. Must register by March 30, 2018. This registration fee covers all expenses except meals in route and incidental personal expenses.</p>
