## *When is my application due?*

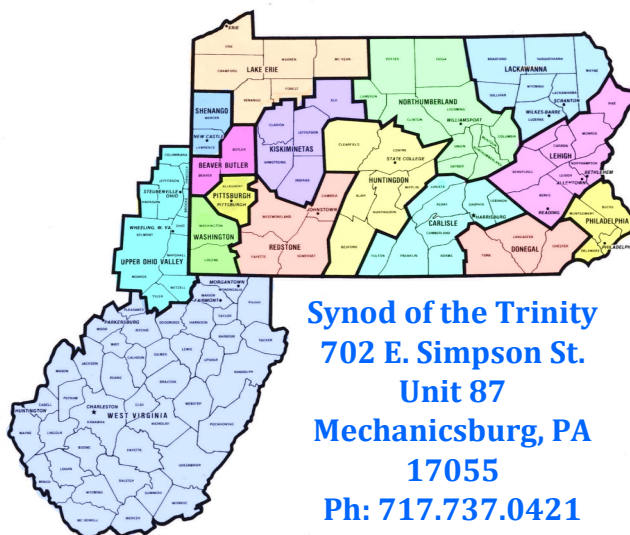
Each grant has its own deadlines. Check the individual grant for specific dates.

## *When will I find out if I have been awarded a grant?*

Decisions on recipients are generally completed within a month of the deadline.

- ◆ Grants will be awarded to applicants until all available funding is expended.
- ◆ Grants are funded through a combination of mission funds and mission reserves.
- ◆ Recently, the Synod of the Trinity awarded more than \$115,000 in grants to deserving presbyteries, congregations and individuals.

### ***Innovation Grant For New Worshiping Communities***

In partnership with the Presbyterian Mission Agency, this grant will assist with a portion of the matching funds necessary for Investment and Growth Grants for New Worshiping Communities (years 2 & 3).



### ***Peacemaking Grant***

If you are interested in sharing Christ's peace and making a difference in the areas of hunger needs, providing underserved peoples with access and education, hate speech and behavior, and the rise of incivility in our culture, this Peacemaking Grant will assist you in your call.



### ***Innovation Grant For Congregationally Connected Campus Ministry***

Congregations can play a vital role in the life of a nearby college campus by providing meals, fellowship, safe space and worship.

This one-time grant will assist a congregation seeking to develop a new, ongoing campus connection.



### ***Partnership Grant***

Ongoing partnership for ministry exist between congregations, congregations and community groups, presbyteries, congregations and presbyteries — you name it. Maximize your work and service potential by developing new relationships through this one-time grant.



### ***Student Study Grant***

Education and vocation discernment are key Presbyterian values. This opportunity, which is available for both undergraduates and graduates, supports opportunities where both may take place.



### ***Mission Travel Grant***

Short-term mission trip travel represents a special kind of mission engagement. Help congregations and individuals put faith into action and deepen their understanding of Christ's call.



### ***Technology Grant***

This grant is intended to support congregations and presbyteries in procuring the technology, technological training and support, and/or technological needs assessment critical to moving forward with their ministry in these changing times.



### ***Ecumenical Grant***

Congregations, presbyteries and Presbyterian supported interdenominational partnerships are invited to dream a local ministry initiative and can apply for a one-time grant of up to \$2,000 to begin that new work.
