2023 Presbyterian Women Summer Gathering Highlights

The 2023 PW in the Synod of the Trinity Summer Gathering met in July at the Penn Stater Hotel and Conference Center in State College, Pennsylvania. Attending were 69 women, including a number of first-time participants, from across the Synod.





Speakers for the general sessions were, the Rev. Forrest Claassen, the Synod Executive of the Synod of the Trinity, Susan Jackson-Dowd, Executive Director of the Presbyterian Women, Inc., the Rev. Cheri Harper, Mission Associate for Presbyterian Women, and Angela Regan, founder and Executive Director of Welcome Home SIS (System Impacted Survivors) our 2022 and 2023 PW Synod Mission Project. Gathering music was led by PWs Patti Hart and Hazel Johnston.

The Gathering offered three sections of small group workshops, most of which were led by PWs from around the Synod with topics exploring, Horizon's Bible Study, PW 101, I Love the Sing the Stories, Disaster Preparedness, Stories of Hymns, Sister Act (about Welcome Home SIS), and a Racial Wealth Gap Simulation.

At the business meeting, we approved changes to the by-laws to update Administrative Team coordinator position titles in keeping with current titles. Additionally, we elected new leaders to the administrative team who were installed at the Tuesday evening program.

The Mission team provided hands on mission activities for Gathering participants to make Christmas cards for incarcerated persons, and fleece knotted blankets for a local project.

During the Gathering participants had the opportunity to bid on 12 baskets provided by each Presbytery. The silent auction baskets raised \$800 and an additional \$725 in donations for our 2023 Mission project, Welcome Home SIS.





The Hunger Fund collection raised nearly \$236. The Contingent Offering collected \$955. Gathering participants also contributed \$358 to PW's Build a Bouquet campaign in celebration of Mary McElroy whose generosity helped many PW's in the Synod bloom. The Gathering concluded with a Blessing of the Hands service and closing worship and communion led by the Rev. Rebecca Tanner.

2023 PWS MISSION PROJECT - Welcome Home SIS

The 2023 PWS Mission Project will continue to support the *Welcome Home SIS -A Safe Space for System Impacted Survivors* project. The project, located in Ohio, helps women who have been released from incarceration rebuild their lives for successful re-entry into society. It is a Christian-based transitional housing and re-entry program, that receives NO government funding, to help women who are more likely to be homeless when released from incarceration. Since 2020, the program has helped 30 women and 19 children, including 8 women and 3 children between January and June of this year (2023). They break down the help needed into several categories:

Immediate Needs: Transportation from prison to the house, Clothing (usually women come out of prison with only their prison sweats) and a nice lunch.

Basic Human Needs - safe housing (rent) and food. The women begin to pay rent after they get a job. **Critical needs for Re-Entry**: **Dignity Bags** with nice girly hygiene items; **Identity Package** for State Identification Card and sometimes birth certificates; and **Advocacy/Benefits** to help with case management and career specialists.


Get Fresh Garden program to help provide fresh fruits and vegetables.
